SUBJECT: ACTION: Concurrence with Office of Environmental Management (EM) request to the Deputy Secretary to approve Critical Decision-4 (CD-4), *Project Completion*, for Argonne National Laboratory (ANL) Project Baseline Summaries for CH-ANLE-0030, Soil and Water Remediation, and CH-ANLE-0040, Nuclear Facility D&D, Building 301 Hot Cell Decontamination and Demolition Project

ISSUE: You are being asked to concur with a request from EM to the Deputy Secretary to approve Critical Decision-4 (CD-4), *Project Completion*, for two projects completed by EM at ANL. The two projects are CH-ANLE-0030, Soil and Water Remediation, and CH-ANLE-0040, Nuclear Facility D&D, Building 301 Hot Cell Decontamination and Demolition Project. Your concurrence will signify Office of Science (SC) acceptance of the transfer of programmatic responsibility for performance of Long-Term Response Actions (LTRA) under CH-ANLE-0030 from EM to SC in FY 2010. No transition of programmatic responsibilities is required for CH-ANLE-0040 as part of this CD-4.

BACKGROUND: As indicated in the enclosed memorandum, EM completed physical remediation activities under CH-ANLE-0030 in September 2003 and ANL has been performing all LTRA activities on behalf of EM since that time. Beginning with FY 2010, all LTRA requirements will be funded by the Laboratory. Both EM and SC agreed that the transition of programmatic responsibility for the LTRA would be a no cost transfer in FY 2010. No EM target funding or full-time equivalents will transfer to SC.

Project CH-ANLE-0040 was completed in September 2009 and transition of programmatic responsibility is not required for the closeout of this project. Likewise, no long-term monitoring costs are anticipated.




